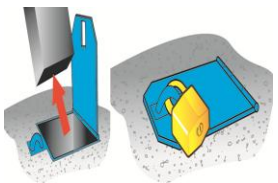


## REMOVABLE BOLLARDS (PRODUCT CODE: HWB/RB RANGE)



### KEY FEATURES – Removable Bollards - Securely Padlock in Position

**Large range of steel removable bollards** with a choice of coloured yellow banding on black posts. Both options have bright amber reflectors to make drivers aware 24/7 day or night.

**Small** - 750mm high for use in driveways and forecourts.

**Medium** - 950mm high for car parks, town centre, supermarkets and garages.

**Large** - 1100mm high for HGV sites, pathway closures and restricted areas in parks.

**The extra large version has two sturdy metal handles** incorporated into the design for easy handling. The lift out weight of the bollards starts at 3 kilos. The heavy-duty version is used by local authorities to control and restrict access to parks etc.

**Securely padlocked in position** into the ground socket. When the Bollards are removed, the galvanised socket lid is flipped closed and padlocked shut, removing the risk of pedestrians' tripping.

**The installation requires a concrete foundation** to set the ground socket in position. The excavated hole should be 300mm square by 400mm deep. The concrete will take at least 24 hours to cure before the Removable Bollard can be locked in place.

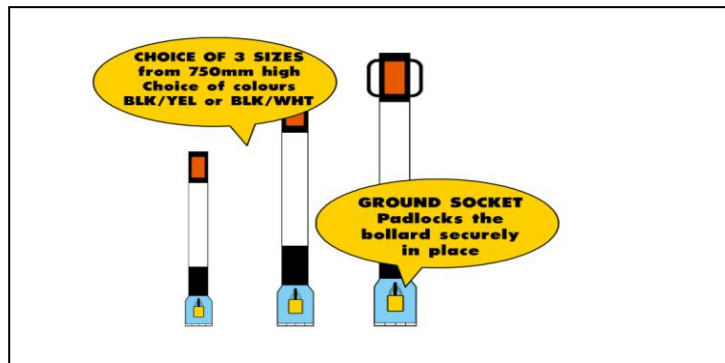
**Easy storage:** to help with storage when the bollards are not in use when they are removed from their sockets. Installing a spare 'parking' socket gives you the option of storing the Bollards to one side...

**Are the Removable Bollards heavy to move and lift in and out of the ground sockets?**

Our range of Bollards are designed to be used safely and the lift out weights are 3 kilos, 6 kilos and the largest bollard is 11 kilos. It is always a good idea to install extra ground sockets to park the Bollards when they are not in use.

**Why are the padlocks not included?**

We have been supplying this product for over 20 years and most people prefer to provide their own padlocks for various reasons including the level of security and the site requiring keys to pass etc...
